

Covid 19 Corona Virus Update 17th March 2020

We have implemented a number of measures to try to protect our members, visitors and staff from the effects of the corona virus as much as is possible.

The actions we have taken are as follows:

18 Hole Course

The course is open as normal at this time. Please observe the following tips when you go out to play

- Leave the flag in, no need to touch it
- Do not rake bunkers. Tidy the sand with feet and allow greens staff to do the raking.
- Only touch your own ball and equipment
- Put some hand gel or wipes in your golf bag
- Do not share other equipment such as rangefinders
- Try to keep 6 feet from fellow golfers
- Do **NOT** shake hands
- After your round wash your hands as advised by NHS

9 Hole Course

The course is open as normal at this time. Advice as above.

- Our hire clubs are being cleaned and sanitised on a regular basis and after being used by customers

Footgolf Course

The course is open as normal at this time. Advice as above.

- All footballs are being sanitised after use.

Driving Range

The driving range is currently open as normal and the bays are adequately spaced to provide the advised social distancing.

- We are asking customers to observe a one way system to access the driving range. Please observe the signs
- Range baskets are being kept in the golf shop and customers should return the baskets to the shop where possible so they can be sanitised for the next customer
- The range is being cleaned on a regular basis and particular attention is being given to sanitising the power tee lids and control panels



Club House and Golf Shop

The clubhouse is currently open and we are taking the following measures:

- Sanitising surfaces such, door handles, fridges, light switches, card payment equipment, coffee machine and any other surfaces that customers may touch.
- Sanitising surfaces such as computers, touch screens, telephones, card payment equipment that staff need to touch to carry out their duties.
- Using disposable cups and plates as much as is possible and practical to do so.
- Using wooden stirrers and separating disposable cups for use with the public coffee machine.
- We have removed some of the tables in the bar and conservatory to create more space and assist with social distancing efforts.
- Where possible doors are being propped open to reduce the need for contact.
- We are asking customers to assist where possible by making contactless payments when using the centre.
