



### Covid 19 Corona Virus Update 13<sup>th</sup> May 2020

We have implemented a number of measures to try to protect our members, visitors and staff from the effects of the corona virus as much as is possible.

The actions we have taken are as follows:

#### **18 Hole Course**

The course is open at this time. Please observe the following guidelines when you go out to play. All members and visitors should make use of the online booking facility as much as possible and ensure that a tee time is booked before arriving at the course.

- Leave the flag in at all times. Holes have been modified to make them shallow and so the ball can be retrieved easily
- Bunkers are ground under repair and rakes have been removed
- Only touch your own ball and equipment
- Ball washers have been covered over
- Do **NOT** sit on any benches around the course or clubhouse
- Put some hand gel or wipes in your golf bag
- Do not share other equipment such as rangefinders
- Try to keep 6 feet from fellow golfers
- Do **NOT** shake hands
- After your round wash your hands as advised by NHS

#### **9 Hole Course**

When the 9 hole course reopens advice will be as above plus:

- Our hire clubs are being cleaned and sanitised on a regular basis and after being used by customers
- There is no booking system in place, please consult the golf shop to find a suitable time to play

#### **Footgolf Course**

When the footgolf course reopens advice will be as above plus

- All footballs are being sanitised after use.

#### **Driving Range**

When the driving range opens the bays are adequately spaced to provide the advised social distancing.

- Customers must observe a one way system to access and leave the driving range. Please observe the signs

- Range baskets are being kept in the golf shop and customers should return the baskets to the shop where possible so they can be sanitised for the next customer
- The range is being cleaned on a regular basis power tee hopper lids have been removed and the control panel should be operated by using the grip end of a golf club.

### **Club House and Golf Shop**

The clubhouse bar is closed but the golf shop and toilets are open:

- Sanitising surfaces such, door handles, fridges, light switches, card payment equipment, coffee machine and any other surfaces that customers may touch.
- Sanitising surfaces such as computers, touch screens, telephones, card payment equipment that staff need to touch to carry out their duties.
- Using disposable cups and plates as and when any takeaway food becomes available
- Using wooden stirrers and separating disposable cups for use with the public coffee machine.
- Where possible doors are being propped open to reduce the need for contact.
- We are asking customers to assist where possible by making contactless payments when using the centre.
- Screens have been installed for the protection of customers and staff and a one way system is in place
- Social distancing markings are painted on the floor outside the shop and a member of staff will be placed outside to assist customers in the queue.

### **Golf Buggies and Hire Trolleys**

Golf buggies and trolleys will be available and will be sanitised before/after use

- Buggies will be restricted to one person per buggy with the exception that two people from the same household may share a buggy. Further information on pricing is available on the website.
